F.H.M.C. MEETING NOTES

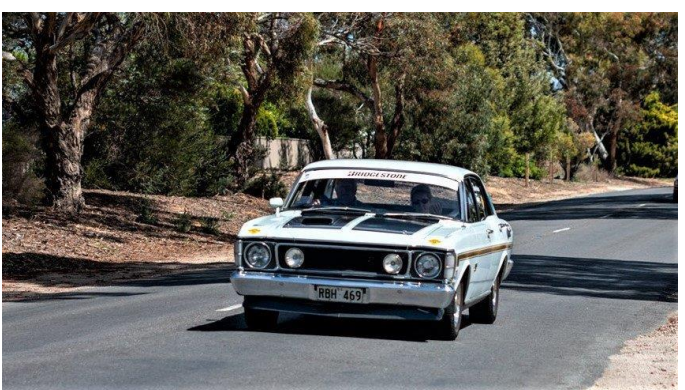
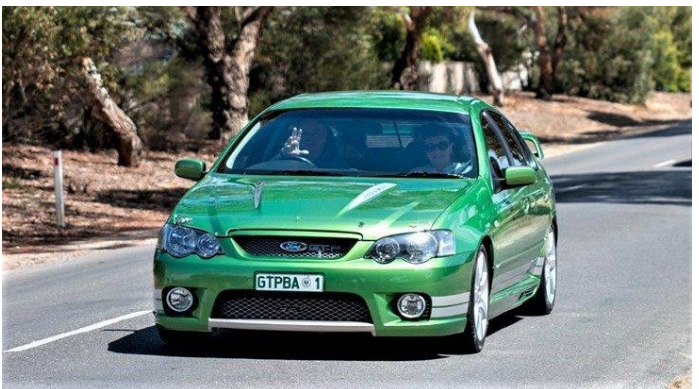
SATURDAY 19TH OCTOBER 2019 @7.00PM

- The new Secretary, Armando Vozzo, was introduced to the club delegates.
- Morgan Custom and Classic & Coffee and Chrome clubs were accepted into the F.H.M.C.
- Many clubs have received approval for grants.
- Treasurers Report indicated a very healthy balance.
- Log Book status generally okay, however, some clubs ordering and paying for Log Books by EFT, are not stating who they are. Log Book Manager very bemused by this as accounting cannot be completed for monies received.
- Federation Tour. Some groups have yet to pay their fees. There have also been some cancellations.
- Motorfest Classic. Shirley Tonkin indicated that this event was well supported.
- Web Site. The F.H.M.C. has now received enough photos for the web site. Alan Pickering is to introduce a calendar for events on the web site, to help prevent the many events being held on the same day. Basic information only required.
- Due to the great success of the picnic held at Wirrina on 15th September, in honour of Arthur Clisby's passing and commitment to the F.H.M.C., it was decided to hold this event on an annual basis. This event will be held on 13th September 2020. There were around 150 vehicles and 15 BSA motor cycles present. From all reports, it was a great day with good food and entertainment. If a club is intending to participate next year, as part of their event calendar, please make sure that the F.H.M.C. are advised. Quite a few clubs just turned up, without notification, which stretched parking and catering availability.
- F.H.M.C. meeting with D.P.T.I. The government is generally very happy with the way the "Club Registration" scheme is being handled. There is just a few bits of house-keeping to attend to. Revision of the "Code of Practice" is proposed for 2022. Astounding statistics revealed by D.P.T.I. Since the "Code of Practice" was revised and effective 1 July 2017, the department has revealed the following vehicles that are on the scheme. **Club Registration- 56,000, LHD- 1,365 and Street Rods- 778.** These figures were questioned by some.
- The meeting with D.P.T.I. also addressed the long ongoing situation regarding LHD Certificate of Exemption. Apparently, the department were a little bemused regarding this inquiry, stating that the log book is also in the glove box of the vehicle which shows name and address. My understanding is that D.P.T.I. will not change what they have in place, but the owner when selling the LHD vehicle can ask the new owner to have the name and address changed through "vehicle standards", but this is not compulsory.
- The subject of vehicle electrification for "Club Registration" was raised. Some thought that this could come under "modified vehicles", others disagreed. It was decided to bring this issue up at the next D.P.T.I. meeting

The weekend of events will include:


- Elvis Tribute Artist Competition
